

Mugie Conservancy offers a set of different activities offered to anyone on a pre-booking basis.

GOLF

Mugie offers a 9 hole golf course surrounded by beautiful aloe gardens and wild olive trees. No conservancy fee is required if vehicles go directly to the golf course. If vehicles are seen driving around, conservancy fees will be applicable.

BLOODHOUNDS

Mugie offers a thrilling bloodhound tracking experience, where guests can leave a scent behind and be tracked by the dogs. This allows a real life insight on the duties and activities of Mugie's K-9 Unit. The activity is available only on a pre-booking basis and for those that overnight.

Please note that the tracking might be cancelled at the last minute if the K-9 Unit is called upon to respond to any incident.

COMMUNITY OFFICE

Mugie offers guests an introduction to its community office in order to create an engagement towards the programs put in place to support its neighbouring communities. This activity has to be pre-booked.

CULTURAL BOMA VISITS

Mugie offers visits to Pokot and/or Samburu Cultural Bomas. This activity is offered in partnership with local women groups and has to be booked at least 2 days in advance.

A contribution of Kes 15,000/- towards the women groups is requested prior to the visit.

NOTES

- Upon arrival at Mugie, all visitors must check in at Headquarters and provide proof of identity;
- A liability waiver must be signed at reception on arrival or online prior to arrival;
- All visitors must pay relevant fees upon or prior to arrival;
- Use of Mugie's and its partner's assets is strictly prohibited;
- Individuals found littering will be subject to a fine of 10,000/- per offence. If a vehicle is found littering it will be charged 4,000/- per seat;
- All prices are inclusive of VAT;
- Water and firewood are not provided by the Conservancy;
- For safety reasons, exiting the vehicle in non-approved areas is prohibited;
- Check in for pre-booked camping has to take place before 6pm;
- Check in for drive-in camping has to take place before 4pm;
- All Mugie rules and regulations must be followed, failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the conservancy without a refund.
